## TECHNICAL APPROACH

### Paving bed

Bedding layer in CEM II 32.5 cement mortar

### → For low-stress areas:

Total binder: 385 kg/m<sup>3</sup>, including 40% CNP

Mix: 140 L of 0/4 sand + 35 kg CEM 32.5 + 20 kg CNP (approx. 2 buckets)

### Pavement joints

### → For high-stress areas:

Total binder: 385 kg/m<sup>3</sup>, including 40% CNP

Mix: 140 L of 0/4 sand + 35 kg CEM 32.5 + 20 kg CNP (approx. 2 buckets)

Optional: TEMPO retarder can be used to adjust setting time.
